ANNUAL COLLEGE FEES

Families are charged each term, an overall amount which covers the College's financial need.

Each term statement will show the following:

- Tuition Fee per student – which is charged to educate your child/children.
- Capital Levy per family – used to pay loans and maintain buildings.
- College Levy per student – used to resource the activities undertaken by students.
- Parents & Community Association (PCA) Levy per family – used to fund priorities identified by the parent body.
- **Voluntary** Building Fund amount of \$80 per term.

Students undertaking study with external Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) or Distance Education providers may have additional fees and levies.

For 3 hours of work in the Library or an approved activity, you are entitled to a \$55 exemption per term.

ACTIVITIES AND MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

The College charges separately the cost of the Year 7 and Year 9 Camps and the Year 12 Retreat (These charges are **compulsory and non-refundable**; every endeavour is made to keep these charges to a minimum). The Year 10 Social, Year 11 RYDA, Year 12 Formal, and the Year 12 Jersey are also charged separately. Other co-curricular activities such as Confraternity/QISSN and Musical will also be charged separately.

Sporting Excellence and Development Academy (SEDA) \$210.00 p.a. for students enrolled in Soccer, Netball and Rugby League. \$315.00 p.a. for students enrolled in Basketball. The SEDA levy is not refundable.

TEXTBOOK HIRE SCHEME

Chisholm Catholic College has an established Textbook Hire Scheme. Its purpose is to provide a service to the school community by eliminating the necessity and financial imposition for parents having to make annual print and digital textbook purchases. Funds approved by the State Government Textbook and Resource Allowance Scheme are used to support and operate this Scheme.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT?

The parent/s and/or legal guardian/s who has signed the Acceptance of Financial Obligation Form with the College is liable for the student's College fees and any other costs associated with the student's attendance at the College.

STUDENTS EXITING AFTER COMMENCEMENT OF A TERM

No refund will be offered on the full term's charges should a student exit the College after the commencement of the term. A full term's charges will also apply to an exited student where official notification occurs after the commencement of the next school term. A minimum of four weeks' notice of intention to leave the College is required prior to the last day of attendance.
