ANNUAL COLLEGE FEES

Families are charged each term, an overall amount which covers the College's financial need.

Each term statement will show the following:

- Tuition Fee per student which is charged to educate your child/children.
- Capital Levy per family used to pay loans and maintain buildings.
- College Levy per student used to resource the activities undertaken by students.
- Parents & Community Association (PCA) Levy per family

 used to fund priorities identified by the parent body.
- Voluntary Building Fund amount of \$80 per term.

Students undertaking study with external RegisteredTraining Organisations (RTOs) or Distance Education providers may have additional fees and levies.

ACTIVITIES AND MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

The College charges separately the cost of the Year 7 and Year 9 Activity Days and the Year 12 Retreat (These charges are **compulsory and non-refundable**; every endeavour is made to keep these charges to a minimum). The Year 10 Social, Year 11 RYDA, Year 12 Formal, and the Year 12 Jersey are also charged separately. Other co-curricular activities such as Confraternity/QISSN and Musical will also be charged separately.
