PERSONAL PRESENTATION AND GROOMING PARTICULARS

The full and correct uniform is to be worn between home and school at all times, including the school hat and blazer (Years 10 and 11). Sports uniform can only be worn between home and school on Thursdays or College sports carnival or representative days. The following particulars exist at all times:

Make-up and fingernails	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make up, including eyelash extensions, are not permitted at the college • Students may wear clear nail polish and if acrylic nails are worn they must be a French tip manicure
Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student may wear a plain wristwatch • One small pendant of religious significance on a chain. • One pair of matching, small studs, or sleepers, with no more than one in each lower ear lobe. • Clear retainers must be worn for all existing additional piercings. • Spaces or stretchers are not permitted.
Hair regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must be neat and presentable, of a natural colour and tied back if below the collar. • Extreme hairstyles which draw attention to the student are quite inappropriate and would not be acceptable. Examples of extreme haircuts include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extreme undercuts, patterns cut into the hair, cuts that make the scalp visible or Mullets or any fashionable cut that contradicts the college hair regulations.
General presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys are expected to be clean shaven. • Students are encouraged to be sun safe and wear an SPF sunscreen • Tattoos are strictly forbidden. • The College sports jacket and tracksuit pant is not to be worn with the formal uniform. • Year 12 students may wear their senior jersey/jacket with any uniform during terms 2 & 3.

HPE LESSONS – MON, TUES, WED, FRI.

Students are required to change into sports uniform for practical HPE lessons, academy, dance or extra-curricula lessons.

When changing for a lesson on a formal uniform day.

- LB 1 & 2** Students can change into sports uniform during PC after roll call before the HPE lesson. Depending on HPE teacher, the student will either get changed into formal uniform at the end of the lesson or at Morning tea in Melaleuca changerooms.
- LB 3 & 4** Students **MUST** change into sports uniform at morning tea in Melaleuca changerooms. Depending on HPE teacher, the student will either get changed into their formal uniform at the end of the lesson or at lunch in Melaleuca changerooms.
- LB 5 & 6** Students **MUST** change into sports uniform at lunch in Melaleuca changerooms. Students **MUST** get changed back into formal uniform at the end of the lesson for travel home.

Uniform infringements.

A uniform is more than just items of clothing. It is a connection, a sense of belonging, a culture, an identity. When a student is out of uniform at Chisholm Catholic College, they are referred to the uniform room.

Students with documented legitimate and extenuating circumstances will be managed on a case-by-case basis in consultation with families, the Pastoral Leader, and the College Leadership team.

Students who do not present to the college more than once in the full and correct uniform and are without a documented, legitimate, or extenuating circumstance will be issued with a breach. Students will not be permitted to attend their classes until the infringement is corrected and will be offered an alternative location on the school grounds where they can access their learning via One Note or may be sent home. In some circumstances, students may be offered a loan uniform item for the day to allow them to access face to face learning.

Students who receive 3 or more breaches may be withdrawn from classes and families required to attend a meeting with the Principal or delegate to discuss their failure to comply with the uniform policy.
